

Private Messaging on MentorSpace 1-to-1

This page illustrates an important point before you begin to use the private messaging feature on MentorSpace 1-to-1, which is located here:

In addition to the ability to communicate via a secure group which can be set up for mentor-mentee discussion, it is also possible to communicate on the system via private messaging.

Private messaging can be carried out in the same manner as email messages, however the primary difference is that private messages are stored and recorded on MentorSpace 1-to-1, and standard email messages are usually stored on a user's computer system.

Therefore, to ensure that MentorSpace 1-to-1 is not used inappropriately, it is designed to be a monitored system. Messages containing inappropriate terminology that might violate the Terms of Use of the site are flagged by the system for monitoring by the administrator. Depending on the severity of the content of a private message that has been flagged for monitoring, this could lead to an account suspension, a complete ban, or even disciplinary action for the sender. So, it is important that all site users read the Terms of Use of the site before using it, which can be found on the front page of the system.
